

Jayashankar M Swaminathan is Kay and Van Weatherspoon Distinguished Professor of the Operations, Technology and Innovation Management area at the Kenan–Flagler Business School, University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Professor Swaminathan is an internationally recognized researcher, teacher and thought leader in global operations, innovation and supply chain strategy. He has published over 50 academic articles on these topics and has been recognized with several awards including the CAREER Award given by the National Science Foundation (NSF). His thoughts have appeared in various media outlets including *Business Week*, *Financial Times*, *Chief Executive* and *CIO Magazine*. Over the last 15 years, Professor Swaminathan has consulted with a number of US and international firms and has given presentations at conferences worldwide. Professor Swaminathan obtained his doctoral and master's degrees in Industrial Administration at Carnegie Mellon University and his bachelor's degree in Computer Science and Engineering from the Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi.
