

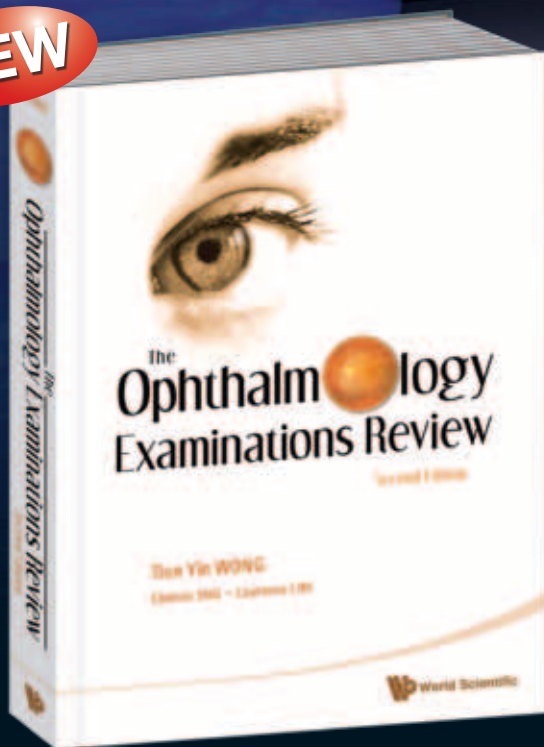

In the new edition, topics such as new understanding of disease mechanisms (e.g., genetics of eye diseases), new investigations (e.g., OCT), and novel procedures and treatment (e.g., the use of antivascular endothelial growth factors, new refractive surgical techniques) are covered.

This book will be a valuable guide to the final year ophthalmology residents and trainees taking the specialist ophthalmology examinations, particularly for exams with a strong oral or viva component. Although primarily aimed at candidates attempting the British postgraduate exams (FRCS, FRANZCO, MRCS, MRCOphth and FRCOphth), it is also useful for other examination systems (e.g., the American Boards). Many junior residents, in fact, find the information handy during grand rounds.

Contents: Cataract and Cataract Surgery; Glaucoma and Glaucoma Surgery; Corneal and External Eye Diseases; Surgical Retina; Medical Retina; Neuroophthalmology; Oculoplastic and Orbital Diseases; Uveitis, Systemic Diseases and Tumors; Squints and Pediatric Eye Diseases; Miscellaneous Examination Problems.
