**Etienne Reuter**, a senior official of the European Commission in Brussels, is the visiting EU Fellow at the Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy for the academic year 2006/2007.

After graduating from the Law School of the University of Strasbourg (France) in 1966, he pursued a distinguished career in European organizations, first in the Council of Europe in Strasbourg and then from 1977 onwards at the European Commission in Brussels. He served as an Adviser to President Roy Jenkins from 1977 to 1981. He later became the Commission's spokesman for the internal market, taxation and competition policies. From 1993 to 2000, he was the EU representative in Hong Kong, after which he spent 5 years at the EU delegation in Tokyo. From 2005 to 2006, he was the head of a special taskforce dealing with Greenland.
