

JIN Renqing, the Minister of Finance of the People's Republic of China, graduated from the China Central University of Finance and Economics. He started his career in Yunnan Province of China. Later he held appointments as deputy finance minister, deputy secretary-general of the State Council, executive deputy mayor of Beijing Municipality, and commissioner of the State Taxation Administration. He has been serving as the Minister of Finance since 2003.

Mr. Jin is one of the key persons in designing and executing China's fiscal and taxation systems and policies. In 2005, he was awarded the Finance Minister of the Year–Asia by *The Banker* and the Asian Finance Minister of the Year by *Emerging Markets*.
