

David A Kelly took a PhD in East Asian Studies at Sydney University, later holding a Fulbright Fellowship at the University of Chicago (1984). He worked in the Contemporary China Center, Australian National University, and School of Politics, Australian Defence Force Academy, and lived in Beijing from 2000 to 2004. Among his works are *Chinese Marxism in the Post Mao Era* (1991) and *Asian Freedoms: Journeys of an Idea in the Cultural Contexts of East and Southeast Asia* (1998).
