

Ramkishen S Rajan is Associate Professor in the School of Public Policy, George Mason University, Virginia, a position he has held since January 2006. Prior to that, he was on the faculty of the School of Economics, University of Adelaide for five years, where he continues to be a Visiting Associate Professor. Professor Rajan has also taught at the National University of Singapore and the Claremont McKenna College and has held visiting positions in various institutes in Asia including the Hong Kong Institute for Monetary Research.
