

Preface

The 10th Asian Logic Conference was held September 1–6, 2008 in Kobe University, Japan. Major funding was provided by the Association for Symbolic Logic, Japan Society for the Promotion of Science, Inoue Foundation for Science and Kobe University. The Program Committee consisted of Chong Chi Tat, Qi Feng, Rod Downey, Hiroakira Ono, Hirotaka Kikyo, Jörg Brendle and Toshiyasu Arai (Chair). The members of the Local Organizing Committee were Mutsunori Banbara, Hiroaki Minami, Ichiro Nagasaka, Akira Suzuki and Makoto Kikuchi (Chair).

The program consisted of three four-hour tutorial lectures given by Byunghan Kim, Greg Hjorth and Peter Cholak, four one-hour plenary talks given by Jeremy Avigad, Justin Moore, Kazushige Terui and Yang Yue, three parallel special sessions (one for model theory, non-classical logics, proof theory and constructive mathematics, one for set theory and one for recursion theory) of 23 invited talks (30 minutes each), and sessions of 23 contributed talks (20 minutes each).

There were 121 registered participants from Australia, Austria, China, Colombia, Czech Republic, India, Israel, The Netherlands, New Zealand, Singapore, South Korea, Spain, United Kingdom, USA and Japan.

Authors were invited to submit papers to the present volume. All of the submitted papers were fully refereed.
