Notes:

1. For consistency, each woman is listed under her birth name (if known). For convenience, there is a heading under the married name referring the reader back to the birth-name entry.
2. Where the individual was a Fellow of the Chemical Society, we have listed the names of the nominators. If any of the nominators was a woman, their name has been underlined and biographical notes will be found under the relevant name entry.
3. In the Biography section, we have only included information which came from verifiable sources.
4. In some publications, details of the author's location and/or affiliation at the time of submitting the manuscript was included. This information can be found in the Publications section in italics and it sometimes provided additional useful employment history.
5. These web pages are a work in progress. We will update them periodically and we hope to have your assistance in completing missing information.
