

**Louis H Kauffman**, Professor at the University of Illinois, Chicago. Professor Kauffman is a renowned theorist in the field of Knot theory. He is the recipient of many awards for his contributions. These awards include: Alternative Natural Philosophy Association Award (1996), Warren McCulloch Memorial Award for Outstanding Contributions to the field of Cybernetics (1993), awarded by the American Society for Cybernetics Lester R Ford Award of the Mathematical Association of American (1978). He was Woodrow Wilson Honorary Fellow (1968), National Science Foundation Fellow (1966-69) and Princeton National Fellow (1966-69). He is the Managing Editor of the Journal of Knot Theory and its Ramifications and the Series of Knots and Everything, both published by World Scientific Publishing. The journal is in its 12 volumes now and there are 32 volumes in the series published so far. He has contributed more than 100 papers in scientific journals and proceedings. Professor Kauffman is also the author/co-author of 14 books.
