

Koh Khee Meng is Professor in the Department of Mathematics at the National University of Singapore. He obtained his PhD from the University of Manitoba in Canada in 1971. Among several other significant appointments, he was the chairman of the Singapore International Mathematical Olympiad Committee (1991–93), a council member of the Institute of Combinatorics and Its Applications (International) (1995–97) and the president of the Singapore Mathematical Society (1996–98). Professor Koh won numerous teaching awards from the National University of Singapore. He specializes in Combinatorics and Graph Theory and has had many papers published in international scientific journals. He is co-author of the books *Principles and Techniques in Combinatorics* and *College Mathematics*, Volumes 1 & 2.
